## **CALL TO ORDER**

Chair Iversen called the meeting to order at 1:28 p.m.

Roll was called and it was determined a quorum was present.

Chair Iversen informed the board that Mr. Stella was unable to attend the meeting and that the service award item would be moved to the April 24<sup>th</sup> meeting.



## **VOTING ITEMS**

## 1. Approve Minutes of January 23, 2014 Meeting

**Motion** made by Vice Chair O'Malley, seconded by Mr. Fauer to approve the minutes. In a voice vote, motion passed unanimously.

# 2. RFQ #946-11345 – General Engineering Construction Management Services for U.S. Customs and Border Protection Facility.

Staff recommended the adoption of the Evaluation Committee's recommendations for ranking the firms, and authorization to negotiate with the top-ranked firm, or successively ranked firms, if negotiations with the higher ranked firm are not satisfactory, for the U.S. Customs and Border Protection Facility.

Mr. Kerney informed the board that he had a conflict of interest and would abstain from voting (conflict of interest form attached).

**Motion** made by Dana Pollitt, seconded by Mr. Volchek, to approve the staff recommendation. Motion carried (9-0 and 1 abstained).

# 3. Memorandum of Agreement for Information Technology Services U.S. Customs and Border Protection Facility – Project 11242

Staff recommended the adoption of a Memorandum of Agreement to reimburse U.S. Customs and Border Protection for providing Information Technology equipment and services estimated at \$208,349.68 and annual support costs for the services in the amount of \$5,179.32 for the U.S. Customs and Border Protection Facility.

Mr. Kwoka mentioned that installation is typically included depending on the duration of the contract and suggested that Customs look into the Verizon T1 contract to determine if it is included or if it could be waived.

**Motion** made by Mr. Kerney, seconded by Mr. Fauer, to approve the staff recommendation subject to the review of the question regarding the installation charges. In a voice vote, motion passed unanimously.

## 4. Airfield Lighting Computer Monitoring System – Project 11909

Staff recommended award of the contract to the lowest responsive bidder, Precision Approach, LLC, of Eatonton, GA in the amount of \$313,835.00 for the Airfield Lighting Computer Controlled Monitoring System.

Mr. Kerney informed the board that he had a conflict of interest and would abstain from voting (conflict of interest form attached).

**Motion** made by Vice Chair O'Malley, seconded by Mr. Carlson, to approve the staff recommendation. Motion carried (9-0 and 1 abstained).

# 5. Foreign-Trade Zone 241 – Operator Agreement with Marina Mile Yachting Center, Inc.

It was recommended that the City enter into an Operator Agreement with Marina Mile Yachting Center, Inc., subject to approval of a Minor Boundary Modification for a Usage Driven Site by the Foreign-Trade Zones Board and approval of an activation request by U.S. Customs and Border Protection.

**Motion** made by Mr. Kerney, seconded by Vice Chair O'Malley, to approve the staff recommendation. In a voice vote, motion passed unanimously.

# 6. Foreign-Trade Zone 241 – Operator Agreement with DFC Services Corporation

It was recommended that the City enter into an Operator Agreement with DFC Services Corp., subject to approval of a Minor Boundary Modification for a Usage Driven Site by the Foreign-Trade Zones Board and approval of an activation request by U.S. Customs and Border Protection.

**Motion** made by Mr. Kerney, seconded by Vice Chair O'Malley, to approve the staff recommendation. In a voice vote, motion passed unanimously.

# 7. Foreign-Trade Zone 241 – Resolution Authorizing City Manager to execute Operating Agreements with Operators

Staff recommended a resolution authorizing the City Manager to:

- 1. Submit applications to activate new foreign trade zone sites to the Foreign Trade Zones Board as the FTZ-241Grantee for the purpose of expediting and attracting FTZ businesses.
- 2. Approve and Execute Foreign Trade Zone Operator Agreements on behalf of City of Fort Lauderdale as the FTZ-241 Grantee subject to approval of the Foreign Trade Zones Board and activation by the U.S. Customs.

**Motion** made by Mr. Kerney, seconded by Mr. Carlson, to approve the staff recommendation. In a voice vote, motion passed unanimously.

### 8. RFP #545-11371 – Foreign-Trade Zone Consultant Services

Staff recommended award of a one year contract with two one year renewals to IMS Worldwide, Inc. for the purchase of Foreign-Trade Zone consulting services for an estimated annual amount of \$76,000.

**Motion** made by Vice Chair O'Malley, seconded by Mr. Carlson, to approve the staff recommendation. In a voice vote, motion passed unanimously.

## 9. Bid #543-11355 – Earthwork Improvements – Parcels B, C, & D

It was recommended that the City award the contract for Earthwork Improvements on Parcels B, C, & D to JMS Construction Services, Inc. in the amount of \$1,278,970.
