Pay Plan Amendment - Schedule I - Police Captains

Direction was given by the City Commission at the Conference Agenda Meeting on September 7, 2010, to go forward with this corrective ordinance. An ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading at the October 19, 2010 Regular Commission Meeting amending Pay Plan, Schedule I, retroactively changing the pay range for positions in the class of police captain. The Public Notice was advertised on October 9, 2010. We are seeking to resolve issues with the City's pay plan, particularly with respect to the two (2) Police Captain positions. The pay equity issue for the Police Captain positions could be resolved via passage of an ordinance provided in the FOP Lodge 31 (Police Lieutenants and Captains) Collective Bargaining Agreement. This ordinance is being introduced again for second reading.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE. FLORIDA, AMENDING SCHEDULE I OF THE PAY PLAN OF CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, RETROACTIVELY CHANGING THE PAY **RANGE** OF POSITIONS IN THE CLASS OF POLICE CAPTAIN, AND FOR SEVERABILITY. REPEAL PROVIDING OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCE PROVISIONS. AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
