Rodstrom, Comm. Rogers, and the City Manager; Mr. Walters to meet with Comm. Dubose; and Vice Chair Deckelbaum to meet with Mayor Seiler and Comm. Roberts. In a voice vote, the **motion** passed unanimously.

Ms. Spangler-Bartle added that she would also include information with the talking points on which other cities have an inclusionary zoning policy with their percentage and success rate.
