A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FINAL OPERATING BUDGET OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2013, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2014, BY APPROPRIATING FUNDS AS SET FORTH IN CITY COMMISSION AGENDA MEMO #13-1228 AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.


WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 13-168, adopted on September 12, 2013, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale adopted the Final Operating Budget of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2013, and ending September 30, 2014,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the Final Operating Budget of the City of Fort Lauderdale for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2013, and ending September 30, 2014, is hereby amended by appropriating funds as set forth in Commission Agenda Memo #13-1228, copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein.


SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.

TITLE: RESOLUTION - Consent resolution approving the consolidated budget amendment

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution amending the Fiscal Year 2014 Budget.

Background

Budget amendments were previously submitted as separate agenda items and listed throughout the City Commission Agenda. Amendments are now consolidated into one agenda item for consideration at the first meeting of each month.

Examples of recommended actions within the consolidated budget amendment are:

- transfer between funds;
- transfer between capital and operating budgets;
- transfer between capital projects;
- acceptance and appropriation of grant funding;
- appropriation from fund balance; and
- appropriation for modified revenue and related expenditures.

Staff is recommending that the City Commission amend the FY 2014 Operating Budget and Community Investment Plan by approving the following transfers and appropriations:

Finance

A. Appropriation between funds balances – Special Assessment and Stormwater Operations Funds - \$998,000

Staff recommends that the funds in the Special Assessment (Stormwater) fund be transferred to the Stormwater fund for future appropriation. The special assessment fund was used for stormwater related projects, but all projects have been completed and there are no pending obligations. Since these funds were originally transferred into the fund from the Stormwater Fund, it is recommended to transfer them back at this time.

Staff recommends the City Commission amend the FY 2014 operating budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the various funds, in the amount of \$998,000 to facilitate future appropriations from the Stormwater Funds.

Fire Rescue

B. Appropriation for modified revenues – General Fund – E911 Dispatch Employee/Services - \$388,000

In an effort to continue E911 Dispatch operations while the County establishes its program, the County has requested that the City of Fort Lauderdale provide the emergency dispatch services, with a full cost reimbursement from Broward County. The estimated costs to provide the emergency dispatch services for the first six months of the fiscal year is approximately \$388,000 and it is currently budgeted.

Staff recommends the City Commission amend the FY 2014 operating budget by amending the appropriate revenue account in the General Fund, in the amount of \$388,000 to facilitate the reimbursement of the emergency dispatch services from Broward County.

Parks and Recreation

C. Acceptance and appropriation of grant funding – General Fund – Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) Grant - \$20,000

The City of Fort Lauderdale was awarded a grant from the Florida Inland Navigation District to reimburse the City for the recent fuel leak clean-up and derelict vessel disposal up to \$20,000. Total costs of the activities related to the fuel leak and derelict vessel were \$37,041.47. The grant acceptance, CAM 13-1256, is a companion item on this agenda.

Staff recommends the City Commission amend the FY 2014 operating budget by amending the appropriate revenue and expense accounts in the General Fund, in the amount of \$20,000 to reimburse the City for the fuel leak clean-up and disposal of a derelict vessel.

D. Acceptance and appropriation of grant funding – Grants Fund – KaBoom Let’s Play Construction Grant - \$20,000

The City of Fort Lauderdale was awarded the KaBoom Let’s Play Construction Grant to supplement the purchase of playground equipment in the amount up to \$20,000. The grant acceptance, CAM 13-1322, is a companion item on this agenda

Staff recommends the City Commission amend the FY 2014 operating budget by amending the appropriate revenue and expense accounts in the General Fund, in the amount of \$20,000 to facilitate the purchase of the playground equipment.

Police

E. Acceptance and appropriation of grant funding – Grants Fund – Broward County Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant program - \$155,216

The City of Fort Lauderdale was awarded the Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement grant from Broward County to continue the City’s Operation Venice America program in the amount of \$155,216. The program improves boat safety education and enhances and/or supplements marine law enforcement activities. The grant will fund up to 3,648 hours of law enforcement and training. The grant acceptance, CAM 13-1113, was approved at the September 3rd, 2013 City Commission meeting.

Staff recommends the City Commission amend the FY 2014 operating budget by amending the appropriate revenue and expense accounts in the Grants Fund, in the amount of \$155,216 for the Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement grant.

Transportation and Mobility

F. Transfer between capital projects – Parking System Fund – Bahia Mar Bridge Rehabilitation - \$306,230

Due to extensive structural deficiencies and enhancements, the Bahia Mar Bridge Rehabilitation project needs additional funding in the amount of \$306,230. Repairs to the bridge have been discovered to be more extensive than originally noted. The funding for the additional repairs and enhancements will be transferred from the South Beach Lot Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Compliance and A1A Walkway project that has been recently completed and under budget.

Staff recommends the City Commission amend the FY 2014 Community Investment Plan (CIP) and Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the amount of \$306,230 to fund the repairs and enhancements to the Bahia Mar Bridge Rehabilitation project.
