A. Roll Call

Chair Muffler called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

B. Approve Minutes of the Board's May 2006 Meeting

No members of the public were in attendance.

Motion made by Ms. Shallenberger, seconded by Mr. Fling, to uphold the findings of Internal Affairs. In a voice vote, the motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Fling stated that Officer Joliet had been his CPI Officer and he could not believe that an officer with over ten years experience would do anything that would demean the Police Department. Mr. Fling felt Officer Joliet always set a good example. Acting Captain DiMaggio confirmed that Officer Joliet had no prior discipline.

Chair Muffler pointed out that a section of the detailed summary was confusing and seemed not to be true. Sergeant London explained that the paragraph to which Chair Muffler referred was Mr. Anderson's version of what occurred. The Board agreed that some of the documentation was confusing; Ms. Shallenberger felt quotation marks could be used to indicate when Mr. Anderson was quoting from Police and supplemental reports.

Ms. Shallenberger felt that overall, this was an excellent investigation. Mr. Fling noted that Sergeant London's investigations were always "superb."

Mr. Fling thanked the Board, the FOP, and Internal Affairs for their support after the recent passing of his partner.

There being no further business before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 7:12 p.m.
