## General Comments:

- Remove bulb-outs and provide Live Oaks @ 30'o.c. (or as close as possible that work with vehicle spacing)
- All transmission lines are proposed underground
- Program parking for retail vs. residential (meters vs. permits)
- Design lighting to accommodate for safety requirements by increasing o.c. spacing (increasing wattage)
- Design lighting as to shield residential units from glare by specifying protective lenses
- Possible addition to lighting ability to have hanging baskets

## S.E. Sixth Street

- West of SE 5<sup>th</sup> Ave. right turn lane into parking garage, left turn straight
- Distance from the building and the curb increase on the south side as per the latest guidelines (14'to street trees)
- Corner of 6<sup>th</sup> and SE 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave., delete parallel parking both sides
- West of SE 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave., royals at 110 building
- @ Andrews Ave. delete parallel parking last spaces each side
- 3 lanes west of Andrews Ave. to SW 4<sup>th</sup> Ave., no parallel parking, maximize landscaping (2 lanes westbound, 1 lane eastbound)

## S.E./S.W. Seventh Street

• Left turn lane at Federal Highway

- Westbound, right turn at 3<sup>rd</sup>, left straight turn
- 2 lanes, no parallel parking from Federal Highway to Andrews Avenue
- Westbound at Andrews Ave., right turn lane, left turn straight
- Eastbound at Andrews Ave, right turn lane, left turn straight
- 3 lanes west of Andrews Ave. to SW 4<sup>th</sup> Ave.( 2 westbound lanes, 1 eastbound lane), no parallel parking, maximize landscaping with the exception of parallel parking on the south side along Hardy Park frontage

## N.E. Fourth Street

- Right turn lane at Federal Highway with minimum stacking distance (2-3 car lengths)
- Parallel parking, whenever possible north and south sides of road
- Existing parallel parking west of Andrews Ave. on south side of 4<sup>th</sup> Street to be moved north
- NE 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave. from Federal Highway to Andrews Ave. no turn lanes
- Andrews Ave. to Flagler, 2 lanes with parallel parking, north side add parallel, owners access from alleys

### N.E. Fifth Street

- No turn lanes on 5<sup>th</sup> Street at corners
- West of Andrews to Flagler, bury transmission lines
- Maximize parallel spaces
