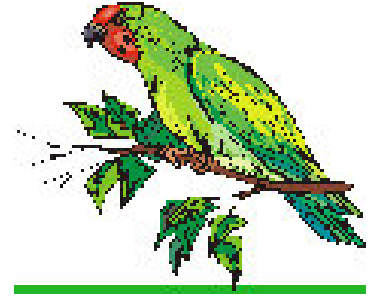

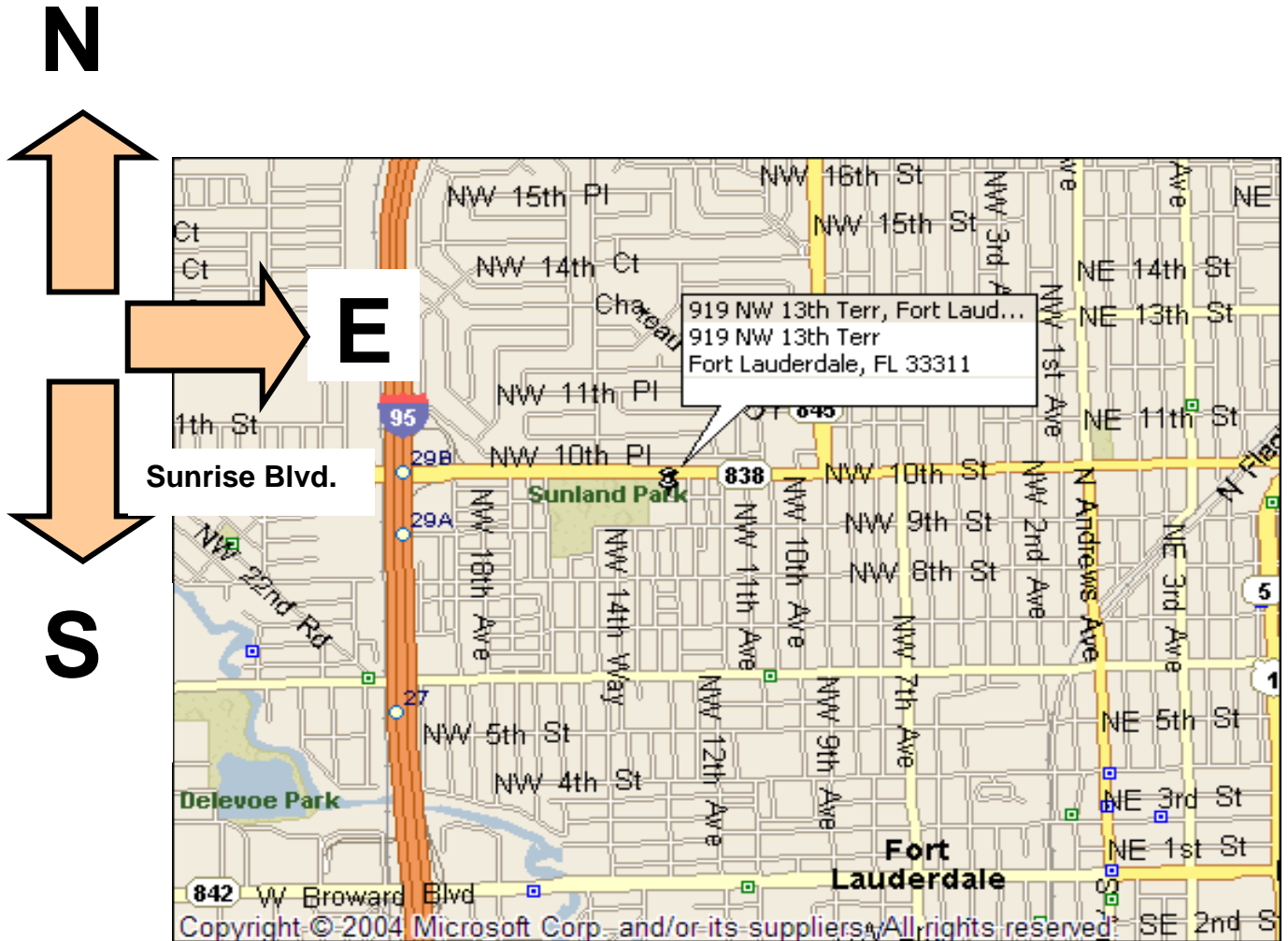
**Principals Message:**
