**ITEM IV. UPDATE – NEW RIVER SMALL BOATING FACILITIES/FLOATING DOCKAGE PROJECT**

**Motion: Mr. Campbell made a motion to have Sea Diversified, Inc. provide Jamie Hart with a written monthly progress report that would be added to the Board's agenda reports.**

**The motion was seconded by Mr. McLaughlin. In a voice vote, the Board voted unanimously in favor.**
