

General site and berm grading to +/-1 linch (1") shall be provided by the general contractor. All finished site grading and final decorative berm shaping shall be provided by the landscape contractor.

All sizes shown for plant material on the plans are to be considered Minimum. All plant material must meet or exceed these minimum requirements for both height and spread. Any other requirements for specific shape or effect as noted on the plan(s) will also be required for final acceptance.

All plant material furnished by the landscape contractor shall be Florida #1 or better as established by Crades and Standards for Florida Nursery Trees and Plants.

All trees designated as single trunk shall have a single, relatively straight, dominant leader, proper structural branching and even branch distribution. Trees with bank inclusion, tipped branches, and co-dominant trunks will not be accepted. Trees with girdling, circling and/or plunging roots will be rejected.

All planting beds shall be fire of all rocks ½" or larger, sticks, and objectionable material including weeds, weed seeds. All limenock shall be removed/closed date to the notine sols. Planting soil 30/30 and/topoal mix shall be delivered to the sale in a clean base and frieble condition and in required round their not bed of all threst configuration covere beds and by a 2" of all stacked on ground covere beds and by a 2" of all stacked on continuous coveres bed to the covered by a continuous covered by the stack of the

All landscape areas shall be covered with a 1" empercial layer of Pine Stress, how larged with a 2" layer of Pine Both multis to a minimum depth of three schoes (3") of but cover when settless (Sevent much to 1" bitschoes 3" ways from the thanks/alters of all joint moderal. All tree in added orwas shall have a clean cut 4" clameter mulch rings, Tile 5-6" height worder may shall be mode from mulch, not soil. 


Failure to comply with any of the above will result in the entire landscape installation to be removed and completely re-planted.








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SOD INSTALLATION DETAIL




