ACTION: The Board voted (9-0) to recommend to the City Commission that a Fall workshop be held in order to discuss possible amendments to ULDR Section 47-23.11, Modification of Required Yards.

• Procedures for the conduct of the Planning and Zoning Board meetings.

ACTION: The Board voted (9-0) that staff work to develop a set of rules and procedures governing guidelines for materials presented to the Board; time limits for the length of applicant, citizen, lobbyist, and Civic Association presentations/comments; and requirements for lobbyist registration.

* - On these items, the Planning and Zoning Board will act as the Local Planning Agency (LPA). Recommendation of approval for these items will include a finding of consistency with the City's Comprehensive Plan and the criteria for rezoning (in the case of rezoning requests).

** - These items are quasi-judicial. Board members disclose any communication or site visits they have had pursuant to Section 47-1.13 of the ULDR. All persons speaking on a quasi-judicial matter will be sworn in and will be subject to cross-examination.
