1 [Inspector Smilen displayed photos of the 2 3 property] 4 As you can see, this is the front of the house. 5 That's a glimpse of the inside of one of the many skylights 6 in the house. Here's another one. 7 MR. LARSON: This fan any good? MR. WEYMOUTH: Ghostbusters. 8 9 INSPECTOR SMILEN: There you go, right there. 10 That's a lot of natural light coming into this structure. Α lot of debris, and - oh - and there's a tree growing right 11 through it. 12 13 MS. HALE: Is that in the [inaudible] INSPECTOR SMILEN: Yes. 14 15 MR. WEYMOUTH: They built the house around the 16 tree, didn't they? 17 MS. HALE: Did they? 18 MR. WEYMOUTH: Looks like it.
